Increases in Both Operating and Capital Funding

The 2013-14 Budget provides additional funding for K-12 education.

We are pleased to announce that the Government of Ontario is providing additional funding for K-12 education. This includes additional funding for operating and capital costs.

Operating and capital funding for K-12 education will increase by 6.7% in 2013-14. This includes an additional \$1.775 billion in 2013-14, \$40.6 million in 2014-15, and \$2.3 million in 2015-16.

In addition, the Government is providing additional funding for K-12 education. This includes an additional \$17.0 million in 2012-13, \$4.5 million in 2013-14, and \$27 million in 2014-15. This funding is for additional staff, materials, and other resources.

The Government is also providing additional funding for K-12 education. This includes an additional \$10 million in 2012-13, \$268 million in 2013-14, and \$5.9 million in 2014-15. This funding is for additional staff, materials, and other resources.

The Government is also providing additional funding for K-12 education. This includes an additional \$119.6 million in 2012-13, \$7.2 million in 2013-14, and \$6.4 million in 2014-15. This funding is for additional staff, materials, and other resources.

Since November 2007, the Government has provided additional funding for K-12 education. This includes an additional \$600 million in 2012-13, \$900 million in 2013-14, and \$1.9 million in 2014-15. This funding is for additional staff, materials, and other resources.
